Some are positioned with an external door which enables access to the paved garden area or internal courtyard. A small private lounge is located close to the rooms with access to the main lounge and dining areas in a central location. All rooms have picture rails for displaying personal mementos. 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The home features many small lounge rooms, with garden views. Each provides for a different experience and is available for socialising or private functions/dining. These have a kitchenette with tea/coffee making facilities and comfortable furnishings. The well-managed library houses over one thousand books including large and normal print, magazines and the daily newspaper, with comfortable reading chairs.

The main lounge room boasts a grand piano, and breathtaking views of the Derwent River. The expansive dining room has a cafe ambience with small tables providing an intimate dining experience. The aptly named Garden Room is suitable for dining with privacy and/or small group activities. This area has been developed with relaxation and sensory experiences in mind. The Chapel hosts interdenominational services and is open for quiet spiritual reflection for residents and/or their family. The secure gardens ensure maximum privacy and quietness. This level paved area is decorated with comfortable garden furniture and has beautiful raised garden beds. Room-side garden areas encourage a sense of community involvement and enjoyment.

An Internet Cafe houses two computers for resident use with tea and coffee making facilities available for residents and families in this area. There is support for residents in the use of this equipment.

The use of the hydrotherapy pool and spa is supported to ensure this can be used safely for both relaxation and exercise.

The Sandown Wellness Centre is designed to assist with physical and emotional wellbeing of residents. A range of therapies are offered to ease the mind, body and soul in a friendly and aesthetically pleasing environment. The home is fully carpeted with quality drapes, fittings and furnishings.

Style and comfort are maintained, creating a warm and inviting environment.

All rooms and ensuites have the universal design principles for people with physical disabilities which supports ageing in place.

There is a comprehensive activity program, delivered by the Leisure and Lifestyle team. Activities are designed to be both interactive and/or relaxing. This varied program provides choice in a wide range of interesting activities.

Functions are always something to look forward to with occasions like the Melbourne Cup, Spring Ball and Easter Parade celebrated. Multi-generational / multicultural events feature regularly including visits from schools and cultural groups.

Our program is also supported by the generosity of our volunteers such as the Librarian who kindly provides her expertise and support. A kiosk is operated by volunteers and provides residents with the opportunity to purchase a small range of personal and treat items. The facility has a Pastoral Carer on staff, whose nurturing support and individual interactions assists with all forms of personal and spiritual needs.

The Sandown Wellness Centre is facilitated by a Registered Nurse, with treatments being provided by a range of skilled and dedicated personnel. A physiotherapist provides individual assessment for residents and is supported by a physiotherapy assistant. The facility also has a visiting podiatrist.

There is a hairdressing salon. The hairdresser will visit residents in their rooms where required.

A visiting beautician is available to provide a range of personal services.

A visiting physiotherapist is available for private consultations.
