Description of quality, condition & amenity of room

Superior

These newly renovated larger rooms are well-maintained with contemporary décor, comfortable furniture and fittings. Each room has access to its own ensuite. Furniture includes built-in wardrobes, a bedside cabinet and over-bed table as well as flat screen television and telephone connected. There is secure storage for personal valuables. Each room has a pleasant outlook to gardens, a courtyard or the surrounding area.

Premium

These newly renovated spacious rooms allow for personal furniture such as a sofa, computer table and/or small table and chairs to share time with family and friends. The rooms are tastefully decorated and each has its own ensuite. There is an expansive wardrobe and drawers for extra storage for greater personalisation of the room and a secure storage area for personal items. Each room contains a bedside cabinet and over-bed table and is equipped with a flat screen television and telephone.

Description of quality, condition & amenity of common areas to which residents will have access

There are comfortable lounge areas with a large screen TV in the main lounge. Each area has its own attractive, sunny dining area with servery. A large well-equipped activity area with decorative murals is used daily for celebrations and special events.

The Chapel, which is supported by the Pastoral Care Officer, provides space for quiet contemplation and multi-denominational church services. There is also a pastoral care suite for use by residents, families and visitors. A family room is available for private gatherings and celebrations.

A keynote feature of the facility is the large indoor conservatory. A water fountain feature is a focal point of the conservatory and seating provides for a pleasant area for residents and families to relax. The facility is surrounded by attractive gardens with raised garden beds and garden ornaments. A sheltered courtyard with walking paths and seating completes this pleasant outdoor environment.

A well-managed cafe / kiosk is available offering a range of food, beverages and gift items for residents, family and visitors. A hairdressing salon on site enables a visiting hairdresser to provide service to residents.

Description of any additional care or services offered at no additional cost A varied and interesting activity program is coordinated by the Leisure and Lifestyle team. This program is supported by volunteers and includes visits by community entertainers. Other activities include art therapy, bus outings and music appreciation. Residents have an opportunity to present ideas and suggestions for this interesting and varied program.

A Pastoral Carer provides support to residents and their families and coordinates a range of interdenominational services and visits.

Kiosk volunteers visit all areas of the home offering residents the opportunity to access this service regularly. Podiatry and physiotherapy services provide service and support to residents and are members of the allied health services.

Description of any additional costs associated with the room

There is a hairdressing salon. The visiting hairdresser will visit residents in their rooms where required.
