Description of quality, condition & amenity of room	<p>Standard These large spacious rooms are tastefully decorated and fully furnished with personally controlled electric beds, wardrobes, carpets and curtains. Within the room there is a lockable drawer for storage or items of a personal nature. There is ample space for additional items of furniture to personalise the room. A picture rail provides the opportunity to display personal mementos. These rooms have large windows providing ample sunlight and all rooms are in close proximity to lounge and dining areas. All rooms have a telephone which receives incoming calls.</p> <p>Superior These large spacious rooms are tastefully decorated and fully-furnished with a personally controlled electronic bed and wardrobes (either built-in or free standing) with private lockable storage space for personal items. Attractive carpets and curtains decorate all these rooms. There is ample space for personal belongings to individualise the room. The rooms have large picture windows allowing for natural lighting with a sunny outlook and attractive views to a courtyard, ocean or the rural environment. Rooms with courtyard views also have direct access from the room into the large paved open courtyard. All rooms are in close proximity to the activity lounge and dining areas. All rooms also have a picture rail for placement of personal mementos, and have a phone for incoming calls.</p> <p>Premium These rooms are significantly larger than the standard and superior rooms and are all modern in presentation and tastefully decorated. Rooms are fully furnished with an electronically controlled bed, wardrobe (either built-in or free standing), bedside cupboard and an over-bed table. There is a private secure storage for personal items. The carpets and curtains are modern. The rooms feature a bay window with space for relaxing in a comfortable chair admiring the sunny views. There is ample space for personalisation of the room. These rooms all have a large window with a sunny outlook to a courtyard, ocean view or rural environment. Rooms with courtyard views also have direct access from the room into the large paved open courtyard. All rooms are in close proximity to the activity lounge and dining areas. All rooms also have a picture rail for placement of personal mementos and a telephone for incoming calls.</p> <p>Deluxe These larger than average rooms have a magnificent view of the Bass Strait and Table Cape hinterland and provide the opportunity to relax while admiring the views and watching the passing sea trade. Located within a newer part of the building, these rooms are all furnished in modern colours and design. The beds are electronically controlled with matching bedside table and over-bed tables are in excellent condition. All furniture has been well maintained. The rooms are tastefully decorated with modern carpets and curtains and ample space within the built-in wardrobes. All rooms have a picture rail for placement of personal mementos, and also have a telephone for incoming calls.</p>

Description of quality, condition and amenity of common areas to which residents will have access

The entry to the home is welcoming, furnished with comfortable arm chairs and features a small café for use by residents / visitors.

A feature of this facility is the many small lounge rooms located throughout the home. Each lounge provides a different experience including the internet kiosk setup with computers for residents' use, the men's room complete with pool table, the craft room, and the larger activity area which provides space to watch the many entertainers who share their talents. These lounges provide plentiful opportunity for socialising. There is a lounge available for private functions/dining. This lounge has a kitchenette and each lounge area also has access to tea/coffee making facilities (some have a kitchenette also) and all areas have comfortable lounge seating. The outlook from each lounge is either out to the beautiful gardens or a paved courtyard with sea views.

The home has a range of decoration reflective of the era including hall tables, china cabinets and arm chairs for relaxing to enjoy the outlook. A wall of prints shows the bygone era of the town and provides opportunities to reminisce and reflect on how the local area has changed over the years. A Chapel provides for quiet contemplation and spiritual reflection and is host to many interdenominational services. The Chapel is open and available for residents and/or their family anytime.

The level courtyard is fully paved and has comfortable garden furniture. Raised garden beds are provided together with room-side garden areas which encourages a sense of community involvement and enjoyment.

The Wellness Centre is designed for the wellbeing of residents. A range of therapies are offered to ease the mind, body and soul in an aesthetically pleasing environment.

All areas of the facility are fully carpeted with quality drapes, fittings and furnishings. Style and comfort are maintained, creating a warm and inviting environment which caters to individual's needs.

Description of any specific accommodation or design features of the room, and the facility, to which a person in this room would have access

All rooms and ensuites have the universal design principles for physical disabilities and allow for ageing in place.

Description of any additional care or services offered at no additional cost

There is a varied and interesting activities program run by the Leisure and Lifestyle team which operates seven days a week and reflects the interests and ideas of the residents. The program incorporates regular bus outings to a variety of different places and events of interest to the residents. Visits around the area are very popular giving people the opportunity to see and explore familiar places. Many entertainers visit the facility and provide performances and enjoyment for residents. A Pastoral Care Officer provides spiritual and emotional support for residents and their families and facilitates a range of visiting clergy.

Volunteers complement the activities program and provide a range of group and individual support to residents and also operate a kiosk which has a range of hand-made items for gifts and special treats.

A physiotherapist and physiotherapy assistant provide assessment and support of residents' mobility, exercise and pain management to promote health and well-being. A range of allied health services including a visiting podiatrist are provided as needed within the facility.

Description of any additional costs associated with the room

A visiting hairdresser and beautician are available for residents to access. There is a regular mobile kiosk delivery throughout the facility from which residents can purchase items.

Personal telephone lines can be arranged as required.
